

Strawberry Festival Jobs

Do we have a job for you! Opportunities for service abound at the Strawberry Festival. Just take your pick:

Pre-Event Day Jobs

- *Slicers n' Dicers* – On Friday, June 4 volunteers are needed to unload, wash, and slice 25+ flats of strawberries.
- *Bakers* – The featured product of our strawberry festival, the *Strawberry Shortcake*, is only a success when we *have* shortcakes to dress with strawberries and cream. Following the recipe by Bisquick® Original Baking Mix from Betty Crocker, bakers are needed to create 25 cakes supplying 300 cubes of shortcake.
- *Food Purchasing Team* – The bulk of the food and supplies are typically purchased on Friday morning before the festival. The SF Committee is looking for 1-2 people to join Diane Adams and drive with her to various wholesalers to purchase supplies, load the van, and deliver supplies to church.
- *White Elephant Table* – Anyone who wishes to donate items for resell at the White Elephant Table should bring them to church on Friday. (Please do not donate clothing or large items. Thank you.)

Event Day Jobs

The good news about these positions is that volunteers can serve as little as **1 hour**; however, it is preferred that volunteers serve in **2 hour time slots** at any one position.

- *Runners* – Modeling just-in-time inventory management, runners are needed to set up food tables in the morning and visit the tables throughout the day to monitor supplies and bring out replenishments as needed.
- *KID ZONE Staff* – The CPC Child Care Center is primarily staffing the Kid Zone exhibits (arts n' crafts & games).
- *KID ZONE Popcorn Stand* – Adults are needed to make popcorn, fill bags, and collect tickets.
- *KID ZONE Moonbounce* – In order to ensure the safety of our young participants, adults are needed to oversee player behavior and monitor player time through the use of stop clocks.
- *Food Table Staff* – Volunteers (aged 12 years and older) are needed to serve the public in preparing food and taking orders at our concession stands. If you've ever been described as friendly, patient, or customer-oriented, you possess the winning qualities of a food table server!
 - *Hotdog Stand* - setups the grill, roasts hotdogs, and collects tickets.
 - *Strawberry Smoothies* – blends smoothie mix with ice, fills cups, and collects tickets.
 - *Strawberry Shortcake* – adds strawberries and whipped cream to shortcake in assembly-like fashion and collects tickets.

- *Chocolate-dipped Strawberries* – exchanges chocolate-dipped strawberries for tickets.
- *Strawberries Sold by the Container* – exchanges prepackaged strawberry containers for tickets.
- *Ticket Booth* – Volunteers are needed to work in pairs with one collecting and counting money while the other detaches and issues tickets.
- *White Elephant Table Staff* –Volunteers are needed to process purchases (in cash, not tickets). Anyone who has experience sponsoring or attending yard sales would be helpful here.
- *White Elephant Charity Transportation* – At the conclusion of the festival any unsold items are donated to a charitable organization. Volunteers (preferably those who own a van, truck, or SUV) are needed to load and deliver the items to the organization.
- *Break Down Crew* – From 2-3pm, a committed group of 10-12 **strong** men and women are needed to break down canopies, carry tables and chairs into Fellowship Hall, collect trash bags and recycling bins, and bring leftover supplies into the church.
